

INTERNATIONAL FAIR : 21ST CENTURY DRAWINGS



The second edition of the **International Fair : 21st Century Drawings** will be held between **March 26th and 28th** in the heart of Paris

Simplicity, easy access, and novelty are the ingredients of this year's edition of the **International Fair: 21st Century Drawings**. During Paris Drawing Week, the IFD distinguishes itself by reinforcing its original style and its mission which is positively future-oriented.

Created by Serghei Litvin, the International Fair: 21st Century Drawings gathers **55 art students, still attending courses at 16 Art Schools from 9 European countries**.

Selected by a jury of diverse personalities from the art world, the students will be showing their best and most recent artworks; **more than 1,000 drawings will be on view!**

Visitors are invited to discover the artworks, meet the students and buy **very reasonably-priced drawings between 100 to 300€!**

The winner of the International Fair: 21st Century Drawing Prize, will be invited to exhibit his work at the **Hadrien de Montferrand Gallery in Beijing**. The Prize will be awarded on Friday, March 26th.

The IFD is a **unique opportunity** for these young students to have their **first professional experience as artists** on the contemporary art market.

The originality of the fair lies on the airy presentation and accessibility to the artworks: the drawings are shown in a large open-space, unframed, in drawing boxes placed on tables.

The 2009 edition was a real success for art amateurs visiting the IFD and 2010 will undoubtedly be even more successful as **IFD's goal is to become a real bridge to promote tomorrow's emerging European artists**.
